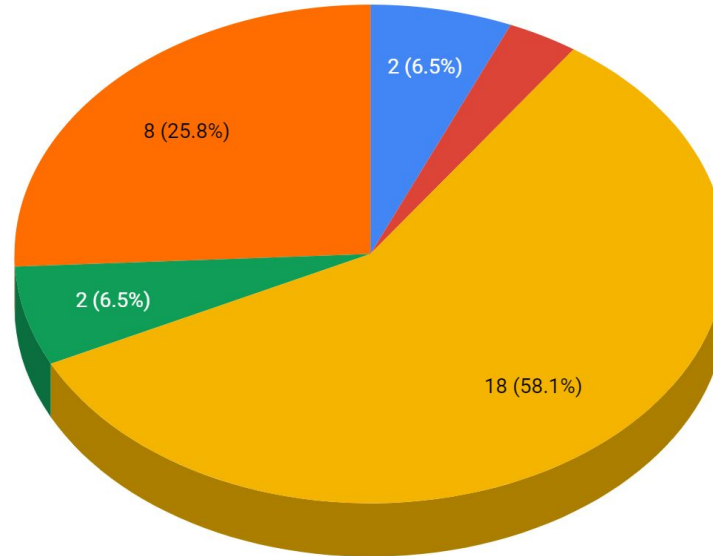

Spacing and retrieval is best.

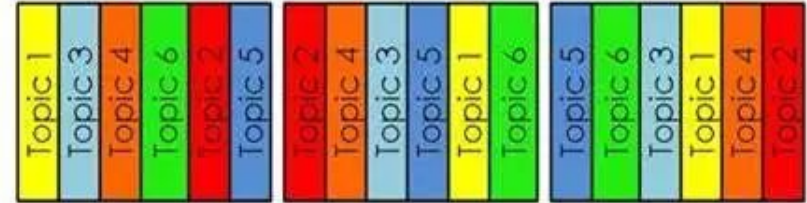
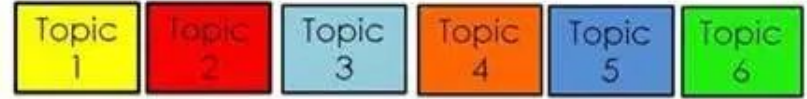
Revision - not just about exams!

Year 12 matters. No external exams but some course do NEA or unit exams.

Students should be constantly revisiting. Research shows practice questions are the most effective tool for securing great progress.

# Enrichment - development of character

Following feedback from students last year I have introduced the Tuesday p5 enrichment programme. It includes recreational sport, reading, life skills, cooking, gardening, leadership opportunities. Exam condition assessments.

Community Service - 10 hours per term is expected per term in Year 12. This is very important to personal statements and applications etc. Many are engaged in peer mentoring and other leadership roles.
