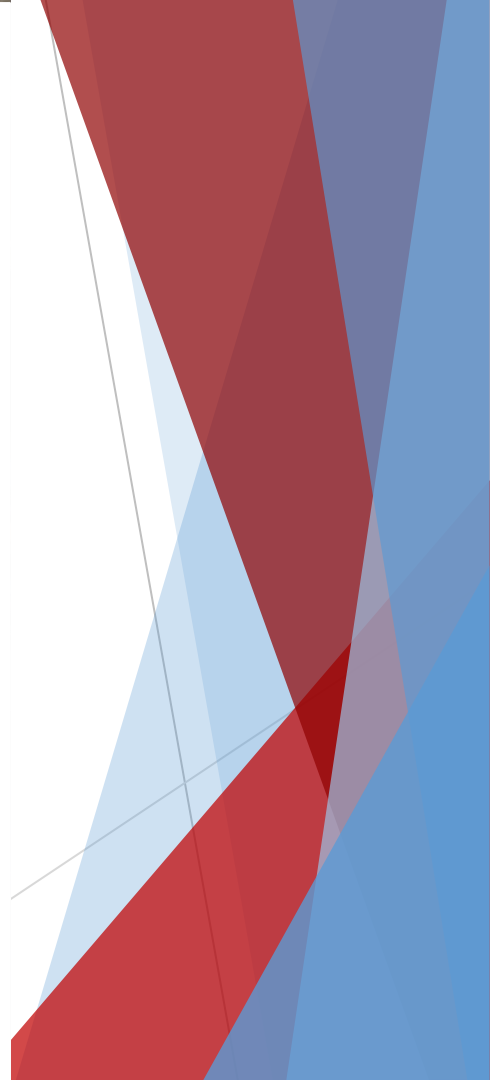
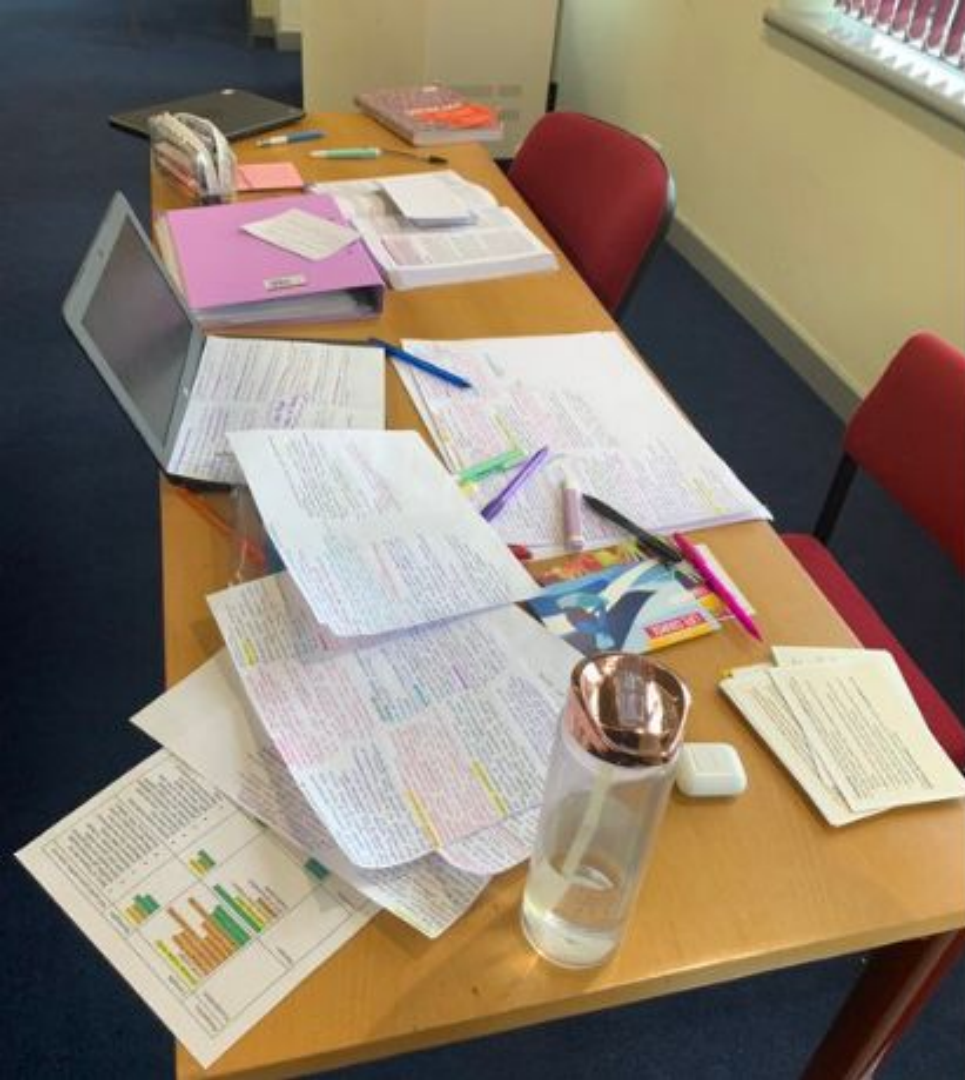
- ★ Students perform in line with national expectation
