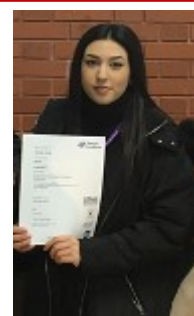

On Monday 2nd December, JCS took a Badminton Team to Dr Challoners' for a friendly fixture.

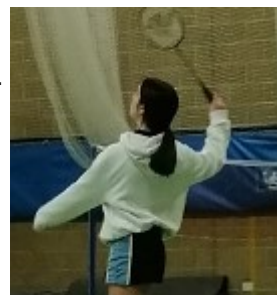
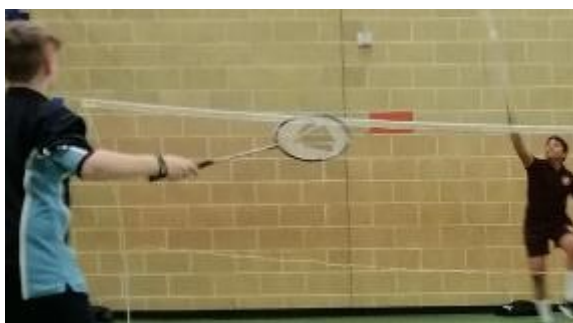
All of the boys put up an excellent fight against the grammar school but unfortunately came up short in both Years 8 and 9. Very well played badminton overall from both teams.

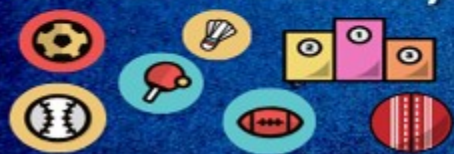
Year 9 Table Tennis
